Southeast Catholic serves families from all six of the South Shore parishes. We offer a **Sacrament Focused Family Format**. This program focuses specifically on preparation for each sacrament. It uses an adult session, a child retreat and parent and child sessions. Families from all of the six parishes participate.

Parish Membership - If you are not registered at a parish or inactive, contact the parish where you attend weekend Mass to register or to renew your membership. Family registration status is verified.*

Baptism Certificate – Children baptized at one of the South Shore parishes do not need to provide a copy of their Baptism certificate along with their registration. All other children need to supply a copy.

Mask Policy – Parents will decide if their family members will wear a mask during the sessions.
